The course has a purpose to provide students with knowledge about socioeconomic aspects of migration processes. Movement of human resources has strong impact on economic development of either donor- or recipient countries. Human capital is one of the key factors of economic development, and this problem is becoming more significant for developing countries, as Armenia is. Special attention is paid on the influence of migration processes on labour market (supply and demand, unemployment, labour force, wages etc.) and financial sector (remittances, investments, capital flows etc.). The course includes corresponding aspects of economic theory.
