The discipline "Crisis management" is one of the basic academic disciplines when teaching students of the Institute of Economics and Business in the direction of "Management".

In the modern world, crisis management is associated with the art of getting out of critical situations, the activities of a person who can seek and choose optimal ways out of crisis situations, mobilize to get out of the most difficult and dangerous situations, use past experience of overcoming crises, adapt to problem situations. Central to learning this discipline is concerned with issues such as foresight and monitoring mechanisms crisis, analysis of its nature, probability, signs, application of methods to reduce negative consequences of the crisis and the use of its results for the future more sustainable development.
