Discipline: Economic theory Annotation Labor intensity: 5 ECTS, 180 academic hours. Final control form: exam

The program of the course "Economic Theory" contains a list of problems, considered in the course of studying microeconomics by students of the first year of the Institute economics and business with a degree in Management (bachelor's degree). The course is designed for 1 semester, for 180 academic hours, of which 68 hours are classroom (34 hours of lectures and 34 hours - practical classes), as well as independent work of students with follow-up control - 112 hours.

The lectures are supposed to present the theoretical foundations of microeconomics, and in within the framework of practical exercises, it is planned to solve problems, conduct a cross survey, solving tests, performing group tasks on the topic, as well as answering

Control questions. In preparation for practical exercises, students master and fix the basic concepts - according to the main literature, as well as according to the topics - for additional.

Students are also provided with assistance in self-study of the material, an additional explanation of the most difficult issues is carried out in an individual okay.

The independent work of students includes the development of a part of the material, intended for self-study, doing homework in the process of preparing for seminars with the solution of relevant problems and cases, answers to test questions and preparation of material for individual and group assignments.

At the end of each semester, an exam is expected to be held for students, for where students demonstrate knowledge of the theoretical foundations of microeconomics and the ability apply them to solve problems.
