Discipline: Economy of the RA and Foreign Countries Annotation Labor intensity: 2 ECTS, 72 academic hours. Final control form: test

This educational-methodical complex for the discipline "Economy of the RA and foreign countries "consists of a curriculum, theoretical and practical blocks.

Over the past 30 years, the number of people living in a rapidly developing environment or in countries with per capita income at the level of OECD countries, increased fourfold - from one to four billion. Growth has accelerated in the global economy as a whole, and - even more - in a wide range of developing countries. Perhaps for the first time in history, a significant part of humanity has a reasonable chance to improve the quality of life and opportunities for creation. The course examines the main approaches to economic development countries, paying special attention to the experience of countries that used the catch-up model economic development. The course is intended for undergraduate students.

The program of the course "Economy of the RA and Foreign Countries" contains practical and theoretical analysis of the problems of economic development of the world economy in general, and also countries of the world in particular. The course is intended for students of economic and non-economic specialties. The course is designed for 144 academic hours, of which 72 - classroom (36 hours of lectures and 36 hours of seminars), as well as independent work of students with subsequent control - 72 hours.

The lectures are supposed to present the theoretical foundations of economic development, and also a detailed and practical analysis of the experience of the countries of the world, economic reforms in order to achieving economic growth in the long term.

Seminars include two main components: testing, which is aimed at testing theoretical knowledge in the field of the studied discipline, as well as various kinds of practical tasks that carry the goal of giving students practical research skills. In particular, the second block includes training

presentations on given topics, group work, discussions, writing a research works (essays), defense and presentation of research work.

Students are provided with assistance in independent study of the material, carried out additional clarification of the most difficult questions on an individual basis. IN independent work of students includes research activities, preparation presentations, group work, familiarization with analytical materials within discipline, homework in preparation for seminars classes, etc.

The score displayed as a weighted average of the current and interim scores controls, is taken as an assessment of exams.
