Summary. The purpose of studying this academic discipline is mastering basic special knowledge, ideas, abilities and skills, necessary to understand the aspects of investment activities, the role investing in a market economy, strategies and achieving investment goals.

When studying the course, lectures, seminars are used, and to identify the degree of assimilation of the material, control works are carried out, tests consisting of exercises, tasks and questions for thought.

The aim of the course is to provide a systematic understanding of the foundations governing investment activity, methods of assessing the financial condition of enterprises, modern financial and economic concepts that determine decisions about investments in various financial instruments.

In accordance with the set goal, the aim of the course is to show and teach students evaluate securities with a detailed fundamental analysis algorithm and the most practical techniques of technical analysis, take investment solutions.
