The course "Information Technology in Management" is intended for student's direction "Management" and is aimed at developing basic skills for working with typical calculations that are used in the field of business, as well as for development practical skills in searching and analyzing information. This course is the basis for studying various software in the future, also students will acquire skills with the help of which in the future they can easily make any calculations using programs.

Within this discipline students will learn in which areas and how information technologies. After studying this discipline, students learn to produce typical calculations, work with databases, find the required information. In detail will be introduced to the tools of the Microsoft Office software package (Excel). During to complete tasks, learn to use the toolkit of these programs and at the end course will acquire the skills of working with the programs. Also, students learn to work in networks, and with the Internet, with a database (search for databases and type in databases).
