In a market economy, the labor of workers in the national economy remains the main the source of social wealth, the main element of production, the main a factor of economic growth, the main means of increasing efficiency production.

However, labor management in a market economy is becoming more complex and responsible business. On the one hand, this requires more preparation, qualified specialists in labor management. On the other hand, significantly the ability of a qualified manager to make a significant contribution also increases in the growth of labor productivity, production efficiency and work success enterprises.

The discipline "*Labor Economics*" is aimed at studying the ways of growth production efficiency through the rational management of labor in enterprises, in organizations.

The course examines the main forms of employment and methods of market regulation labor, sources and structure of income of the population, factors and reserves of growth labor productivity, methods of its measurement. The elements of the organization are examined wages, special attention is paid to the regulation of labor, the construction of tariff nets, the optimal choice of various different remuneration systems, as well as the methods calculation of the number of personnel of enterprises.
