The course "Logistics" is devoted to the study of theoretical, methodological and practical issues of forming an integrated material management process, information and other related flows to ensure maximum possible satisfaction of the needs of consumers with a minimum overall cost. IN within the framework of this discipline, the issues of logistic-oriented analysis are studied and management of material and labor flows, increasing the level of efficiency organization and management of processes, management of material and information flows, development and implementation of logistics systems, deepening knowledge in the field modern mechanisms and methods of system organization and management of streaming processes in supply chains.

The course covers the main components of logistics at all stages economic activity - from the source of raw materials and materials to delivery finished product, service presentation and after-sales service.
