The course is a sequential presentation of scientific, theoretical and practical foundations of the system of state and municipal administration. As well as disclosure of basic concepts and categories of state and municipal management, outlines the main approaches of the state structure, complex processes of formation of legal, socio-economic foundations of modern democratic society.

The course covers functions and structure public, state and municipal sectors, factors of their growth and management. Theories of the state, public administration and its organizations. The main focus is on the formation of the goals of the economic policy, theory and technology of public administration, regional and municipal processes, social movements and phenomena, state regulation of the market.

Methodologically, the course is based on the study of the mechanisms of functioning state and municipal authorities, complex structuring of the system of bodies various levels of government and the main areas of activity of political, economic, social institutions based on the use of systemic, structural functional, situational, synergistic approaches, attention is focused on organizational and managerial issues in state and municipal management. Particular attention is paid to the disclosure of the features of the functioning system of public administration in general, and its branches in particular in countries with different political regime, state structure, various forms board. Within the framework of this discipline, scientific and theoretical features of the formation of the system of local self-government, model of organization local government and models of interaction of local government with government bodies.

Communication with other disciplines. “Models of public administration in developed countries” as a discipline that explores the scientific, theoretical and practical problems of state and municipal administration, based on knowledge disciplines: "Constitutional Law", "Civil Law", "Macroeconomics", "Statistics", "Economic history", etc. It is presented in close relationship with economic, legal, political science and other humanities.

Requirements for the initial levels of knowledge and skills of students for passing discipline. When studying a discipline, it is assumed that the student studied in to a large extent owns the basics of economic theory, management, constitutional, administrative and other types of law, information technologies, socio-economic statistics.
