

Discipline: Philosophy

Annotation

Labor intensity: 4 ECTS, 144 academic hours.

Final control form: test.

The course gives students an understanding of philosophy as a special form of spiritual culture, knowledge about its place and role in society, about the process of the formation of philosophy, about its main topical problems: an idea of the structure of scientific knowledge, of the place of a person in the world, as well as an explanation of the role of philosophy in social relations, which should contribute to the formation of a certain worldview position among students, based on the philosophical principles they have learned.

The purpose of the discipline. To instill in students the ability to be independent, reflective, critical thinking and the ability to take them in the subsequent scientific, social, practical activities.

Objectives of the discipline by acquainting students with the historical philosophical problems:

- a) to give students knowledge about current philosophical problems and their solutions in different modern philosophical trends.
- b) to make students understand the specific features of philosophy as one of the different from others (including science) forms of spiritual culture and its connection with their specialty.
- c) contribute to the formation of a certain worldview position in the student
