

**Discipline: Political Economics**

**Annotation**

**Labor intensity: 2 ECTS, 72 academic hours.**

**Final control form: test with assessment**

The course "Political Economics" is devoted to the study of basic theoretical and practical issues related to the problems of transition of post-Soviet countries space, as well as countries of the former socialist camp from the system administrative-command economy to a market one.

Special attention will be paid to the transitional processes in the Republic of Armenia, as in the field of economics and in the field of politics.

Within the framework of this discipline, students will study practical issues related to the specifics of the transition processes in each individual country will be considered models of the transition from a planned economy to a market economy. The problems of monetary credit, fiscal, foreign economic, antitrust and social state policy in the process of transition, assessed positive and negative the consequences of the reforms. Issues will be considered in detail state policy of the transition period in the Republic of Armenia.
