## Discipline: Socio-economic statistics Annotation Labor intensity: 4 ECTS, 144 academic hours. Final control form: exam

The study of this subject is aimed at developing the basic knowledge about the essence of basic tools and practical skills in the field socio-economic statistics. the situation of the population. In addition, the course provides for practical classes, including the solution of statistical problems, the study of social economic indicators, their trends, as well as forecasting methods, used in socio-economic statistics.
